



Photography at The MAX

We encourage visitors to capture their visit and share on social media and tag @msartsorg, but we have a few rules to protect the exhibits and to respect other visitors' experiences.

- Photography is permitted for personal, noncommercial use only with small handheld cameras/devices.
- Flash photography is not permitted.
- Tripods, monopods, Gimbals, and other camera extensions such as selfie sticks are not permitted.
- Provocative outfits are prohibited as we are a child friendly facility.
- Any clothing or items containing glitter are prohibited indoors.
- Photography of certain exhibits on view may be prohibited. Please look for signage in the galleries indicating where photography is not permissible.
- Photography must be conducted without disruption to other visitors, Museum operations, or limitation to the accessibility of exhibitions, entrances/exits, doorways, and high-traffic areas.
- Photographs taken by visitors cannot be published, sold, reproduced, or otherwise commercially exploited in any manner. The MAX is not responsible for any uses of visitor photography that infringe upon third-party copyrights or other rights.

Staged/Group Photography (Over 3 people)

Permitted during normal business hours (Tuesday-Saturday, 9:00am-5:00pm) and must adhere to the following:

Indoor Photography

- Limited to the downstairs Hall of Fame area and the lowest section of stairs (not above the first landing) and cannot block access to stairwell for other visitors.
- Not permitted in areas of public or private events, setup for events, or spaces affecting events such as entrances, exits, load-ins, staging areas, etc.

Courtyard Photography

- Does not require a security escort.
- Will not be permitted if a private event is being set-up or taking place.

Rooftop Terrace & 2nd Floor Lobby Photography

- Requires a 72-hour advanced reservation and a fee of \$100 if equipment (i.e., tripods, lighting) is used and/or for access to the rooftop terrace. Two-hour time limit and advanced payment required.
- Requires a security escort.

The MAX reserves the right to change this policy at its sole discretion and/or refuse access and/or photography rights to any visitor or group, at anytime, anywhere on museum property.
